CALLED THE THOUSAND AND ONE NIGHTS. ALSO CALLED THE THOUSAND AND ONE NIGHTS, THIS BOOK IS A CLASSIC WORK OF ARABIC LITERATURE. THE WORK IS MADE UP OF APPROXIMATELY TWO HUNDRED STORIES FROM PERSIA, INDIA, AND OTHER COUNTRIES IN AND NEAR THE MIDDLE EAST. ITS STORIES WERE COLLECTED AND WRITTEN DOWN IN ARABIC IN ABOUT A.D. 1500. BRITISH SCHOLARS SIR RICHARD F. BURTON AND JOHN PAYNE TRANSLATED THE STORIES INTO ENGLISH IN THE 1800s.

In creating the story of Ali Baba, author Marie P. Croall worked from *Arabian Nights Volume I: The Marvels and Wonders of the Thousand and One Nights*, adapted from Richard F. Burton's unexpurgated translation by Jack Zipes. Artist Clint Hilinski consulted numerous historical resources to shape the visual content of the tale. In addition, Allan T. Kohl, art historian and visual resources librarian at the Minneapolis College of Art and Design, lent his expertise to the project by reviewing both text and art. Kohl has studied the Arabian Nights tales and authored an article on one of the stories in the collection.






































































































































GLOSSARY AND PRONUNCIATION GUIDE

SCIMITAR (*sib*-meh-tahr): a sword with a curved blade
